L.I.F.E. Day Support is an innovative program that helps adults who have a developmental disability develop functional skills and discover their talents through volunteer work.

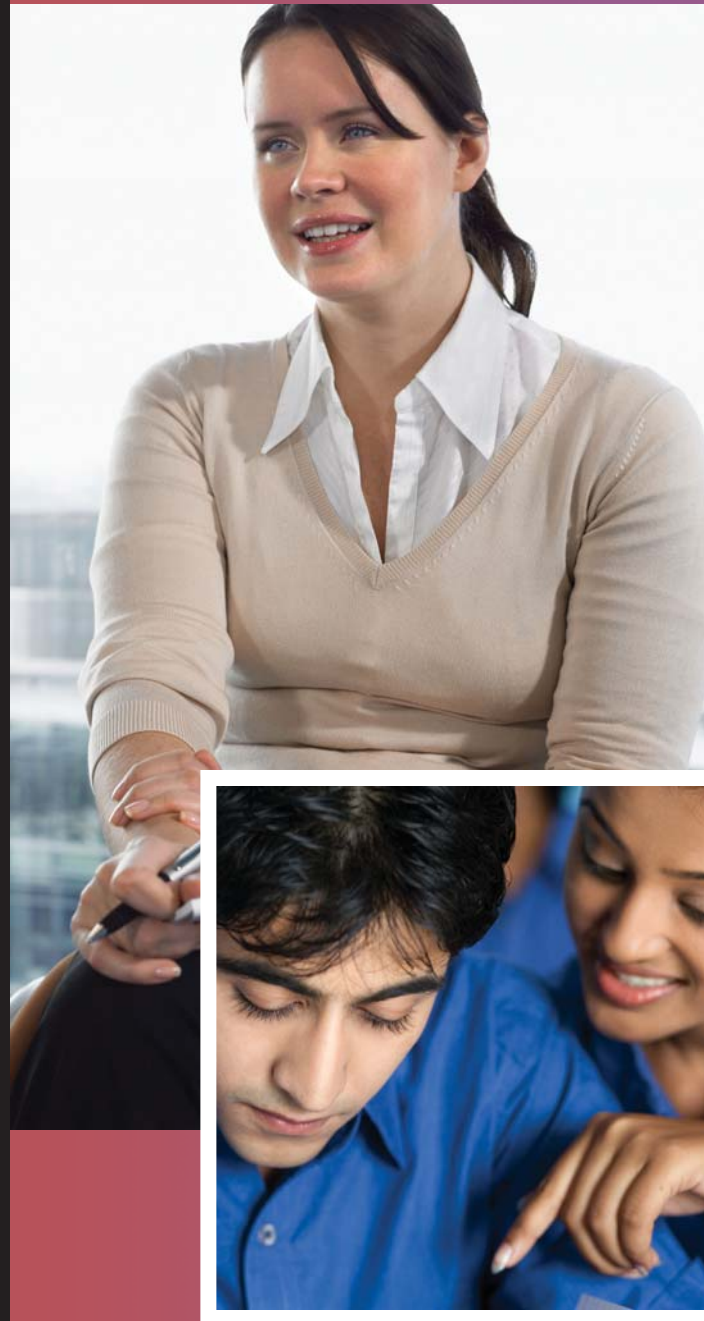
We have found that controlled experiences in volunteer settings stimulate individuals with a developmental disability in ways that traditional work experiences cannot.

With guidance and support, these experiences become opportunities for such individuals to grow and build confidence. Individuals in the L.I.F.E program learn social, community, personal and vocational skills.

L.I.F.E. is not only a learning opportunity; the program gives individuals with developmental disabilities a chance to become locally involved and connected.

By creating more local opportunities to volunteer, L.I.F.E. provides these individuals with a chance to establish constructive relationships within their own communities
